# Delivery and registration

- 1. The price submitted will include delivery to Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council's Depot, at 48 William Street Gundagai and include the provision of the vehicles first scheduled service. All vehicles are to arrive with NSW registration for a period of 12 months and include registration paperwork to demonstrate appropriate registration.
- 2. Reimbursement of the cost of registration will be made separately; therefore the cost of registration should be invoiced independently.
- 3. Council will supply the Compulsory Third Party Insurance and the registration letter of authority to the successful supplier.

# Transport for NSW – Requirements

All vehicles must meet all Transport for NSW requirements. Any manufactured equipment i.e. modifications must be fitted with the necessary engineers compliance plates.

# Safework - Requirements
