GUNDAGAI EFFLUENT REUSE PROJECT STAGE 1:

At its Ordinary Meeting held 27 August 2024 Council resolved (Item 8.7.1) to place on public exhibition the Gundagai Effluent Reuse Project Stage 1 works at a value of \$300,000 for a period of 21 days. This is in accordance with the 23A Guidelines issued by the NSW Office of Local Government, under which CGRC is required to operate at the present time.
