REPORTING OF DOG RELATED INCIDENTS:

Council Rangers are reminding all residents to **report any** dog-related incidents to the Council, no matter how small. Recent investigations into major incidents have revealed that some minor incidents were not reported, which could have helped prevent further issues. Reporting even minor incidents may help to reduce the chances of another event occurring and allow the Council to take appropriate action. According to the NSW Companion Animals Act, a "dog attack" is defined as any dog that rushes at, attacks, bites, harasses, or chases a person or animal. By reporting all incidents, you can contribute to a safer community for both people and pets.

GUNDAGAI EFFLUENT REUSE PROJECT STAGE 1:

At the Ordinary Meeting held 27 August 2024 Council resolved (Item 8.7.1) to place on public exhibition the Gundagai Effluent Reuse Project Stage 1 works at a value of \$300,000 for a period of 21 days. This is in accordance with the 23A Guidelines issued by the NSW Office of Local Government, under which CGRC is required to operate at the present time.
