## **D. DUTIES**

- 1. Drive and operate heavy combination vehicles to load, carry and unload materials, liquids, equipment and objects to complete civil construction and maintenance works.
- 2. Control traffic at worksites and assist with the erection of traffic signage.
- 3. Assist with worksite preparation, measuring, marking and basic levelling.
- 4. Maintain worksite/workplace tidiness and cleanliness.
- 5. Support other plant operators through directing movement of plant and loads and communicating work site conditions and information.
- 6. Use and maintain tools and equipment effectively to complete tasks efficiently.
- 7. Attend to repairs, maintenance and cleaning of Council assets as directed.
- 8. Undertake labouring duties as directed.
- 9. Respond to emergency situations as requested.
- 10. Complete required workplace records.
- 11. Operate other mobile plant and trucks as directed and to the level of training and licensing achieved.
- 12. Undertake training to update, maintain and advance personal skill levels and in compliance with relevant workplace legislation.
- 13. Respond to inquiries from members of the public and provide information within scope of responsibility.
