Under the NSW Companion Animals Act 1998, cat & dog owners must take **two steps** to provide their pet with lifetime protection: **Permanent Microchip Identification & Lifetime Registration.** Microchip Identification & Lifetime Registration greatly assists Council in returning your pet to you if they are lost, hurt or stolen. It also provides the Council with a more effective means of keeping track of cats & dogs for the benefit of the wider community.
