COOTAMUNDRA CHRISTMAS/NEW YEAR GARBAGE COLLECTION SERVICES

Residents of Cootamundra, Stockinbingal and Wallendbeen are advised that garbage collection for the Christmas & New Year period is as follows: If your normal collection day is Wednesday 25 December 2024, collection will be Tuesday 24 December 2024.

If your normal collection day is Thursday 26 December 2024, collection will be Friday 27 December 2024.

There are no change to collection services on Wednesday 1 January 2025.

The Waste Depot will be closed on Wednesday 25 and Thursday 26 December 2024, and on Wednesday 1 January 2025. Outside of these public holiday closures operation will be as normal.

GUNDAGAI CHRISTMAS/NEW YEAR GARBAGE COLLECTION SERVICES

If you have a green bin collection service on Wednesday 25 December, your green bin will be collected on Tuesday 24 December, please leave your bin out the night before.

There will be **NO** garbage bin collection services on Wednesday 25 & Thursday 26 December. (Public Holidays).

If you have a recycling bin for collection on Thursday 26 this bin will now be collected on Friday 27, please leave your bin out the night before.

If you have commercial bin collection services on Friday 27 December this bin will be collected on Saturday 28 December 2024.

Council apologises for any inconvenience and reminds residents to leave bins out the night before as collection times may vary during this period.
