**HOVELL STREET COOTAMUNDRA REHABILITATION:**

CGRC will be undertaking rehabilitation work on Hovell Street (above) in Cootamundra. The project will see the lowering of services through the road, renewal of kerb and upgraded pavement suitable for the heavy vehicle detour. Residents & motorists should be aware that work will start in late January with the relocation of services (water & Gas). Minor disturbances to kerb side parking & utilities in early February. The project will be completed in three stages. Detailed discussions with affected businesses will take place.
