## **B. STATEMENT OF FUNCTION**

Undertake repair and maintenance duties required by Roads and Maritime Services contracts to maintain the State Road network.

#### **C. KEY RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 1. Ensure State Road network maintenance work is completed within required time frames.
- 2. Ensure all work activities are undertaken efficiently and effectively to achieve Councils goals and objectives.
- 3. Ensure all work is undertaken according to Safe Work Method Statements, Council policy and RMS guidelines.

#### **D. DUTIES**

- 1. Assist with the collection of State Roads inspection data from computerised record system (Reflect), record completed tasks and upload task completion information.
- 2. Clear and remove vegetation, rubbish and debris from highways, roadsides and streets using manual and mechanical equipment and chemicals.
- 3. Manually maintain surface drainage systems including drains, culverts and pollutant traps.
- 4. Install and maintain roadside fixtures, including signposts, guideposts, barriers and fencing.
- 5. Manually collect and empty rubbish bins.
- 6. Control traffic at worksites and assist with the erection of traffic signage (subject to qualification).
- 7. Manually repair roads, pavements, pathways, footpaths and bikeways using tools, equipment and/or machinery.
- 8. Undertake and comply with risk assessments and work method statements (WMS) in relation to worksite activities.
- 9. Assist with worksite preparation, measuring, marking and basic levelling.
- 10. Carry out manual excavation with due care of underground services.
- 11. Spread and compact materials manually.
- 12. Attend to repairs, maintenance and cleaning of Council assets as directed.
- 13. Respond to emergency situations as requested and including afterhours call outs.
- 14. Complete required workplace records.
- 15. Operate mobile plant and trucks as directed and to the level of training and licencing achieved.
- 16. Respond to inquiries from members of the public and provide information within scope of responsibility.
- 17. Carry out any other duties that are within the limits of the employees' skill, competence and training.

### **E. ESSENTIAL CRITERIA**

- 1. Demonstrated experience in a labouring role preferably gained within a civil works environment.
- 2. Current NSW Class C Drivers Licence or above or equivalent.
- 3. WHS Construction Induction (NSW White card) or equivalent.
- 4. Demonstrated experience in the operation and maintenance of small plant and equipment.
- 5. Demonstrated literacy and numeracy skills to follow written communication and complete standard forms.
- 6. Demonstrated interpersonal and communication skills.
- 7. Working knowledge of roles and responsibilities under the WHS Act 2011.

## F. DESIRABLE CRITERIA

- 1. Current Class MR Drivers Licence or above or equivalent.
- 2. RMS Traffic Controller Certification (Blue Card or equivalent).
- 3. RMS Traffic Control Implement/Apply Traffic Control Plans certification (Yellow card or equivalent)
- 4. Chainsaw Operations certification.
- 5. Completion of Chemical Handling Certification (e.g. ChemCert, SMARTtrain) or ability to readily acquire.
